Please find below guidelines from the Anglican Diocese on how to safely return to having services in Churches. These guidelines have been adapted to suit our church and Parish. An attendance register for every service will be kept by the Parish.

Service times Sunday: 8am, 9.30am and 11am

Wednesday: 10am

Please register for these service as only 20 parishioners allowed per service.

Please DO NOT attend if unwell.

Entry:

Services will be held in the main body of church.

Please enter at main door and follow directions to seating.

Please use sanitiser provided when entering.

Please bring a bed sheet to place on your seat.

Seating

Will be distanced 1.5 metres apart

Please remain in your allocated seat

Service

Service Booklets will be provided for each parishioner attending.

Eucharist will be in one kind.

Exit

Please exit through Chapel door.

Please sanitise hands upon leaving.

Please do not gather in small groups on Church grounds.

Church cleaning

Following each service the church needs to be cleaned and this will be done by a selected member of those attending each service.

Collection Plates

Will be located in front of the altar (we understand that some people have been keeping their weekly collections at home until able to bring to a church service).

Private Prayer

At this stage, the Church will remain closed other than service times.
